Hi Leonie,

RMS generally only issues a numbered “Type Approval” certificate for complex safety-critical devices (such as traffic light controllers) – you will note from TS200 that there are not many devices in this category.

The Dritel 3G phone will be listed in TS200 as “RMS Accepted”, and as such it will not require a certification certificate.

Please advise your customers that the Dritel 3G phone is approved for supply to RMS and is listed in **TS200 Ed1 Rev6** (Sep 2016) as an “Accepted” device.

Publication of TS200 Ed1 Rev6 on the internet has been delayed – in the interim this email can be provided as proof of RMS acceptance, or ITSHelpdesk can directly endorse supply of Dritel 3G phones via email as required.
